

Agenda for Future Action

1. Short Term Horizon (0-7 years)
 - Complete 2 additional Strategic Growth Area Implementation Plans
 - Complete 'Form-Based Code' amendments in the CZO for the Oceanfront and Pembroke Areas. Begin 2 other SGAs.
 - Complete a well-coordinated planning and implementation strategy that advances intermodal transit service in Virginia Beach and complements a larger metropolitan transit system
 - Complete a Pungo Implementation Plan to include land use, zoning, design, transportation, infrastructure and other strategies.
 - Complete a Virginia Aquarium District Plan to provide guidance for the future expansion and improvements of this cultural and environmental resource.
 - Establish a community-based and prioritized planning strategy that lays the groundwork for implementation actions to further improve the form and function of the Shore Drive Corridor. The study should include, among others, sites in the vicinity of North Great Neck Road and Northampton Boulevard Areas.

2. Long Term Horizon (7+ years)
 - Begin construction of improvements to Interstate 264
 - Begin construction of the Southeastern Parkway and Greenbelt

4. Sustained Activities
 - Public Outreach - Continue effective public dialogue as part of an ongoing process to learn, inform and obtain feedback on a range of comprehensive planning issues.
 - Regionalism - Working with other metropolitan localities and the Hampton Roads Planning District Commission, promote regional initiatives that will result in an improved quality of life and economic vitality for the entire metropolitan area. These include the further coordination on transportation, water, solid waste and other regional needs.
 - Neighborhood Safety - Continue supporting policies and programs designed to improve public safety in our neighborhoods, including the city's *Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design* (CPTED) and *Traffic Calming* programs.
